Hilda Pope’s mother brought her to the United States from Cuba when she was six years old. Since then Hilda has lived in New York, Florida, and for the past 50 years, Arizona. Today, Hilda has health issues and can no longer drive. After her husband’s passing earlier this year, she called upon Duet for rides to the grocery store.

Pam Celley, along with her two daughters, Madeline and Caroline, are National Charity League (NCL) volunteers who were matched with Hilda through Duet in

spring 2009. They meet with Hilda twice a month. In the time they spend together, they like to hear Hilda tell stories. “She’s really nice and thoughtful and funny and always has new stories to tell us,” says Pam. “We like talking to her about Cuba and her father. He was a cinematographer in Cuba. And she’s tremendously grateful. We’re happy to help her.”

Since receiving Duet’s services, Hilda says she has learned how kind people can be. “There is something inside your heart when you read so many awful

things in the papers and then you see that there is so much goodness; I can’t even describe it,” she says. “Because to me, Pam and her daughters are like they came out from heaven.”

A Duet of Giving and Receiving

Imagine a white sheet of paper with a small, black dot in the center. What do you see? According to Sherry Layne, most people only see the dot, without seeing the larger page. Sherry explains this is how many people, who are disabled like herself, feel about their disabilities. "It's

just a spot, and not the whole page of who we are," she says.

Sherry has two layers of disabilities. She has a genetic disorder called Usher Syndrome that caused her to be born partially blind and deaf. She also has inner-ear damage that came from "toxic" loud-noises exposure. After this exposure, Sherry says she went from being "socially active" to being a homebound adult.

That's when Duet connected Sherry to her two volunteers, Diane Arens-Miller and Marlow Myers-Garay. "[They] saw the 'whole page' of me from the moment we met, and it's been heart-warming to have my disability needs understood and assisted from our first meeting on," she says.

Diane grocery shops for Sherry, while Marlow provides her with friendly visits. Sherry describes their volunteer assistance as being "self-empowering."

"The biggest help I've receive from their helpful support is my re-discovery of the self-esteem I'd believed I'd lost," she says. "I see Diane and Marlow's voluntary

help to me as an ideal demonstration of interdependence at its best - a successful 'duet' of giving and receiving. ✨

Outpouring of Support Breaks Fundraising Record at Duet's Poinsettia Tea

Indian School, at 10 a.m. This group is co-facilitated by Duet and the Area Agency on Aging, Region One.
