**DUET OFFERS PREP COURSE  
FOR FAITH COMMUNITY NURSES**

**(Phoenix, AZ)** – Faith community nurses, or parish nurses, play an integral role in the faith community they serve. They provide support for health, wellness and healing to their congregation members.

Duet's Faith Community Nurse Basic Preparation Program teaches registered nurses how to provide healthcare to members of a faith community. The interfaith class provides interactive experiences that help participants acquire the necessary skills to become a faith community nurse.

This four-day course will take place from November 8 through 11 at the Desert Cross Lutheran Church in Tempe and costs \$400. This fee covers course materials and resources, the required textbook and lunch each day. The class will cover many topics including spirituality, professionalism, holistic health and community. Participants also will receive 34.24 contact hours from the Arizona Nurses' Association upon completion of this continuing education course. Registration deadline is **October 25** and space is limited, so sign up now.

**WHO:** Registered nurses interested in becoming a faith community/parish nurse or starting a congregational health program.

**WHAT:** Duet's basic preparation course for faith community nurses. The cost for this four-day class is \$400, which includes lunch each day, course materials and the textbook.

**WHY:** A parish or faith community nurse is a registered professional nurse, actively licensed in Arizona, who serves as a member of the staff of a faith community. They play an important role in the health, wellness and healing of the community.
