2017 Foundations of Faith Community Nursing Course

Duet is proud to present the Foundations of Faith Community Nursing Course. The educational experience is open to all registered nurses with active licenses. This program is an interfaith course that teaches experienced RNs how to provide wholistic healthcare to members of a faith community.

What is Faith Community Nursing?

Faith Community Nursing is a specialized practice of professional nursing that focuses on the intentional care of the spirit as part of the process of promoting wholistic health and preventing or minimizing illness. This practice is guided by the following general principles:

- Effective healthcare requires more than medical treatment of disease or illness.
- Promotion of health and healing are part of the mission and service of a faith community to its members.
- Wellness and wholeness can only fully be achieved when we acknowledge the close connection between body, mind and spirit.



This course is based on the curriculum developed through the International Parish Nurse Resource Center (IPNRC), Church Health Center, 1210 Peabody Ave., Memphis, TN., 38104. Duet has been approved by the IPNRC to offer the standardized curriculum.

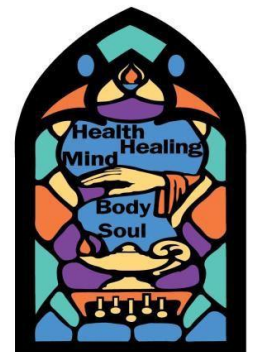

Enrollment Requirements

- Be a registered nurse with an active license.
- Have access to a computer to complete online course modules.

Format

- Foundations course work uses a hybrid format consisting of online modules and community assignments that complement class time.
- Two hours of online module work must be completed prior to the first scheduled class. The remaining 9 hours (online and class assignments) will be completed over the 4 week break between classes.

Faculty

- This course will be taught by experienced faith community nurses as well as various content area experts from the greater Phoenix area.

Continuing Education

- This continuing nursing education activity was approved by the Western Multi-State Division, an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.
- Phoenix area Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, and Utah Nurses Associations are members of the Western Multi-State Division.
