Duet is proud to present the Foundations of Faith Community Nursing Course. This educational experience is open to all registered nurses with active licenses.

What is Faith Community Nursing?

Faith Community Nursing is a specialized practice of professional nursing that focuses on the intentional care of the spirit as part of the process of promoting holistic health and preventing or minimizing illness. This practice is guided by the following general principles:

- Effective healthcare requires more than medical treatment of disease or illness.
- Promotion of health and healing are part of the mission and service of a faith community to its members.
- Wellness and wholeness can only fully be achieved when we acknowledge the close connection between body, mind and spirit.



This course is based on the curriculum developed through the Westberg Institute for Faith Community Nursing, a ministry of Church Health Center, 420 North Cleveland Ave, Memphis, TN, 38104. Duet has been approved to offer the standardized curriculum.

Enrollment Requirements

- Be a registered nurse with an active license.
- Have completed spiritual assessment upon registration for the course.

Format

- Foundations course work uses a hybrid format consisting of community assignments that complement class time.
- The course presents comprehensive instruction over five class days, three in September and two in October.

Faculty

 This course will be taught by experienced faith community nurses as well as various content area experts from the greater Phoenix area.

Continuing Education

- An application for this activity for continuing nursing education units has been submitted to the Western Multi-State Division, an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.

Cost: \$400* includes:

- 36.5 continuing nurse education hours.
- Continental breakfast each morning, lunch, refreshments, course materials, and resources.

Note: We reserve the right to cancel the course if there is an insufficient number of qualified applicants. In the event of cancellation, registered participants will receive a full refund Or credit for the next scheduled course.

Thanks to a grant from the BHHS Legacy Foundation, the full \$400 tuition will be reimbursed for graduates who begin congregational health programs within six months of completing the course.
