Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) Report

The 39-month driver's license record is required <u>only</u> for volunteers who drive our homebound adults in their vehicle.

- Follow the instructions below to obtain a "39 Month Uncertified MVR" (Motor Vehicle Record.)"
- There are two options to complete the request for a 39-month Uncertified MVR regarding your driving record, online or in-person.
- There is a \$3 service fee to obtain the record.

Instructions Online:

- 1. Create an AZMVD account online: https://azmvdnow.gov/home
 - Fill out the information in the application.
 - You may have already created an online AZMVD account for services such as vehicle registration or a replacement driver's license.
- 2. In the upper left-hand corner, look for the "Driver License & ID" tab. Click on "Driver License Record Request."





- 3. On the drop-down menu, click on "39 Month Uncertified MVR."
- 4. Click "Add to Cart" to checkout.





- 5. After you check out, you will receive a PDF copy of your driver's license record.
- 6. Save the PDF and email a copy to Duet for our records.

Instructions In-Person:

- 1. You can go in-person to a MVD office, complete an application there, and receive the results while you wait.
